First, you MUST be logged in to access the online donation form.

- > The form can be found under the DONATION tab on the HOME page; choose FUNDRAISER ITEM DONATION from the dropdown menu.

Spoofed Phone Calls Claim Fraudulent Activity and Ask for Sensitive Personal Information

We've been made aware of members receiving fraudulent phone calls from individuals claiming to be from the Credit Union. In these instances, the phone number they are calling from is "spoofed," meaning it might appear to be a legitimate Delta Community contact number. The caller states that there has been a fraudulent charge on the member's account and asks the member to confirm his or her identity.

Delta Community actively monitors and alerts members for potential fraudulent activity on their accounts, but please be aware that we will never ask you to provide your ATM, Debit Card or telephone access (IVR) PIN.

If you suspect an incoming call is fraudulent or spoofed, please hang up and call our Member Care Center at (404) 715.4725 or toll-free at (800) 544.3328 for assistance.

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5 WAYS TO PROTECT YOURSELF FROM IDENTITY FRAUD

The recent hack of Marriott/Starwood, compromising 500 million guest records,
provided a sobering reminder of the need for consumers to stay vigilant.

The Delta Information Security team recommends these tips to protect yourself from identity theft and personal information misuse:

- 1. Change passwords regularly: Use a unique password for every online account (but if you have re-used passwords, change all shared account passwords) and never re-use your Delta password.
- 2. Monitor financial accounts: Check your bank and credit card accounts at least monthly. Sign up for financial institutions' notification services that monitor for unauthorized transactions.
- 3. Credit security freeze: If you suspect identity fraud, set up a credit security freeze with each of the three major credit bureaus (Equifax, Experian, TransUnion). A credit security freeze locks access to your credit information until you give permission for release of your data. During the freeze, no financial organization/lender can check your credit score and no one will give you or a criminal pretending to be you a loan or credit card. When you want to get a new loan or credit card, unlock your credit services.
- 4. Social engineering vigilance: Be diligent about phishing emails, phone calls or text messages. Cyber attackers often take advantage of recent incidents in the news to try to trick you into providing personally identifiable information. Most legitimate organizations will never ask for your password by phone or email. For tips on how to recognize phishing or social engineering attacks, visit the Deltanet Information Security portal.
- 5. Marriott/Starwood services: Visit the Marriott answers website* for updates about their breach and information on how to set up their free WebWatcher service that alerts consumers when their personal info is found on questionable sites. (*https://answers.kroll.com/)

If you believe you are the victim of identity theft or personal information misuse, contact the Federal Trade Commission and/or your state Attorney General's office.
