  - Print ONE to include with the item or simply use the paper form they completed.

WALL STREET JOURNAL NAMES DELTA BEST U.S. AIRLINE OF 2019

- The yearly ranking is determined by metrics such as delays, canceled flights, involuntary denied boarding and complaints.
- Delta received the award for the third consecutive year.

Scott McCartney, veteran airline reporter for the WALL STREET JOURNAL, highlighted Delta for ranking No. 1 on the annual list of best U.S. airlines of



2019, despite "stronger everyday storms and more congestion" than last year - further separating us from our competitors.

Some Delta competitors mentioned the rise in intense weather and increasing climate change as obstacles to maintaining and managing strong and reliable operational performance.

Dave Holtz, S.V.P. - Operations and Customer Center, shared with McCartney that, "While the weather itself is out of our control, how we react to that weather, plan for that weather and work through that weather is certainly within our control."

McCartney also highlighted Delta's continually improving industry-leading cancellation rate. "Delta says its mainline operation had 281 days with zero cancellations last year, 30 more than in 2018. Factoring in regional partners, the total number of days when 100 percent of flights were completed was 165, up 143 in 2018," McCartney wrote.

Delta improved its on-time arrival rate despite increased congestion and weather from the previous year. McCartney highlighted a significant gap between Delta ranked No. 1 and all competitors that follow in the ranking.

# WING FLIGHT CREW AMONG "WOMEN CHANGING THE WORLD" SAYS INSTYLE MAGAZINE

We've always known Delta to have some stellar employees - all 90,000 strong are at the heart of Delta's success - but INSTYLE MAGAZINE just made it official.

The monthly fashion and culture magazine released their annual list of 50 BADASS WOMEN FOR 2020, and in it, they named the entire crew of Delta's WING FLIGHT as their No. 10 pick among "some of the greatest changemakers of our time, from all over the world."

For International Girls in Aviation Day, we flew 120 girls ages 12-18 on our 5th annual Women Inspiring our Next Generation flight to visit NASA's Johnson Space Center. The flight is part of Delta's efforts to close the gender gap in aviation and expose young women to a wide variety of career opportunities in Science, Technology, Engineering and Math, among other fields.

"The girls clapped as we barreled down the runway," Delta First Officer Erin Heinlein told Instyle. "Hearing their joy brought me back to the excitement and wonder I felt on my first flights."

"We know representation matters. At Delta, we believe you have to **see it to be it**," said Beth Poole, General Manager - Pilot Development, in October during the event. Poole helped start Delta's WING FLIGHT in 2015 and has helped plan the flight ever since.

In INSTYLE's print edition, the WING flight crew shared a double-page spread with NBC News' Savannah Guthrie and Hoda Kotb and were among global influencers that included Susan Goldberg, Editor-in-Chief of NATIONAL GEOGRAPHIC; Sue Gordan, a former Deputy Director of NATIONAL INTELLIGENCE; Zarifa Ghafari, Afghanistan's first female mayor; sexual assault survivor and activist Amanda Nguyen; and many others.

## DELTA CELEBRATES DR. KING'S LEGACY WITH \$400K CONTRIBUTION TOWARD MLK JR. NATIONAL HISTORICAL PARK Source: Delta Corporate Communications | Community Involvement | January 17, 2020



Delta has committed \$400,000 to the National Park Service to provide for upgrades and renovations at the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historical Park in Atlanta.

This contribution will significantly improve the lighting and electrical systems at the promenade and visitor center access areas for the guest experience at the park. It will also enhance safety and security. The expected completion date is 2021.

The contribution further demonstrates our commitment to our hometown, Atlanta - and to celebrating Dr. King's legacy.

In 2019, The Delta Air Lines Foundation provided a grant to the National Park Service to keep the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historical Park open and operating during

the federal government lapse in appropriations. Following Delta's grant, the park saw a record number of visitors during Martin Luther King Jr. weekend.

The National Park Service is honored to partner with Delta Air Lines again in providing visitors an encounter worthy of the great treasures preserved and interpreted here at the Martin Luther King Jr. National Historical Park."
